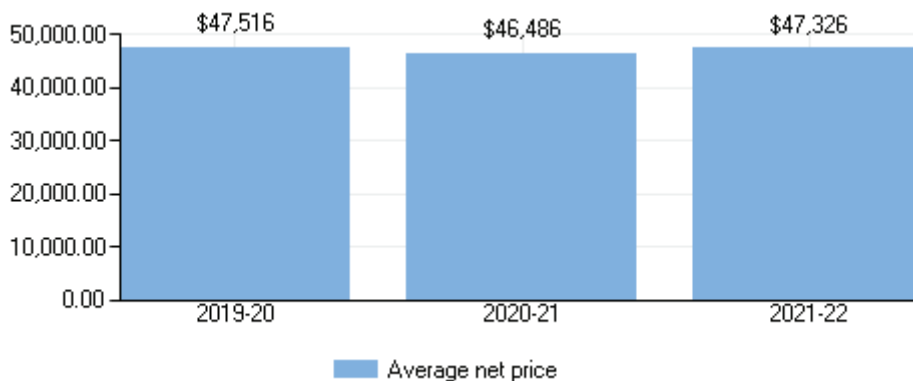

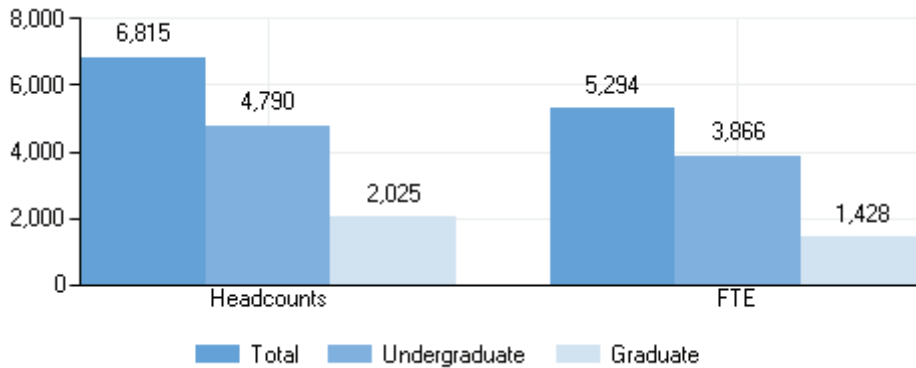


Average net price of attendance for full-time, first-time, degree/certificate-seeking undergraduate students who were awarded Title IV aid by income: 2019-20 - 2021-22

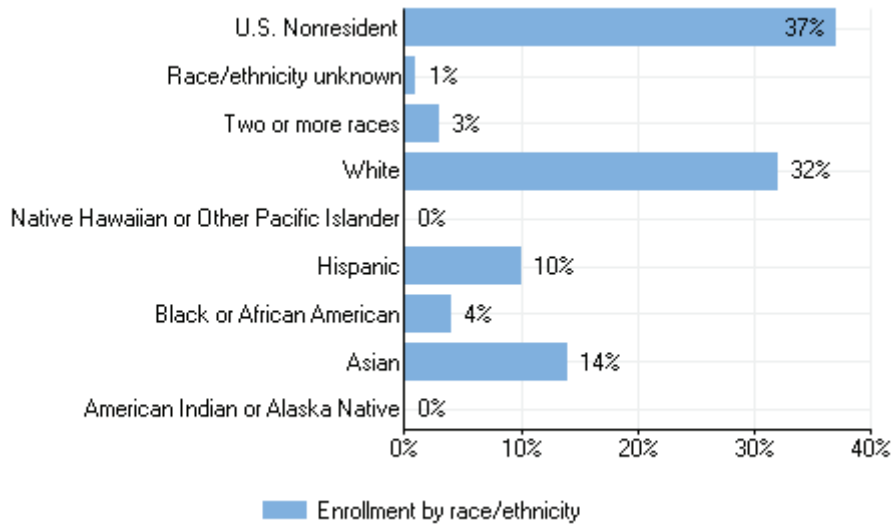
Unduplicated 12-month headcount and total FTE, by student level: 2021-22



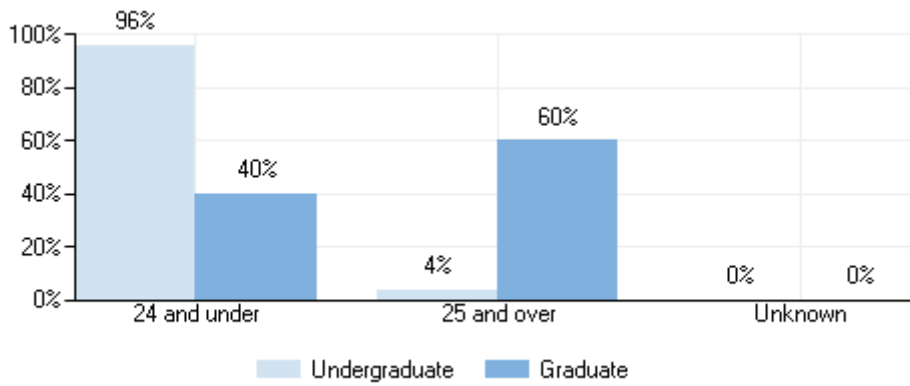

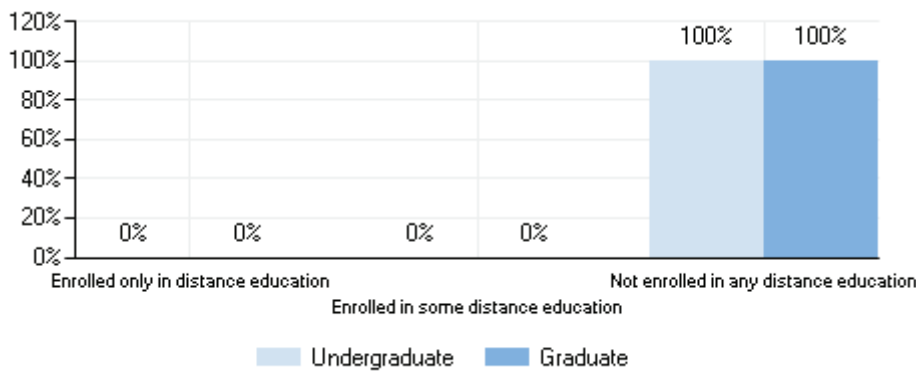
Percent of all students enrolled, by race/ethnicity: Fall 2022



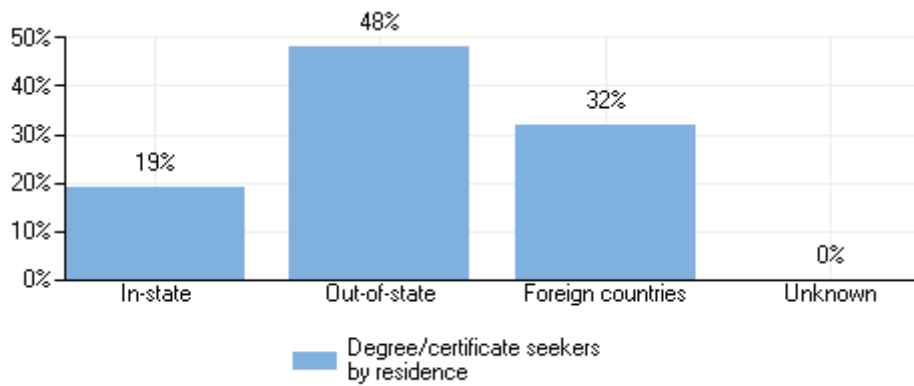
Percent of all students enrolled, by age: Fall 2022

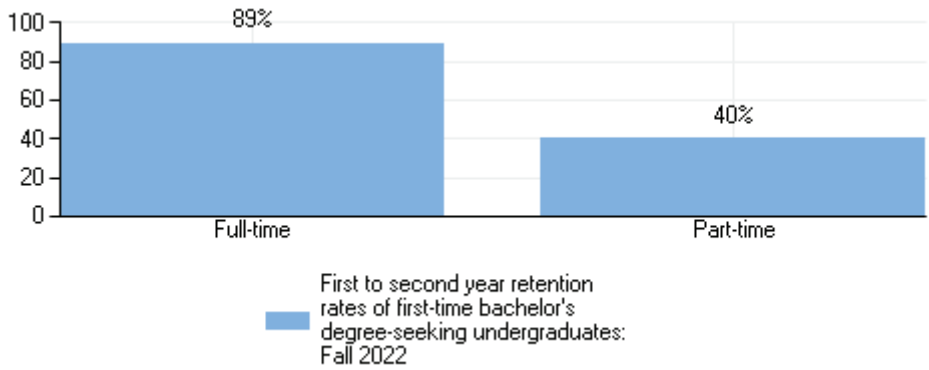

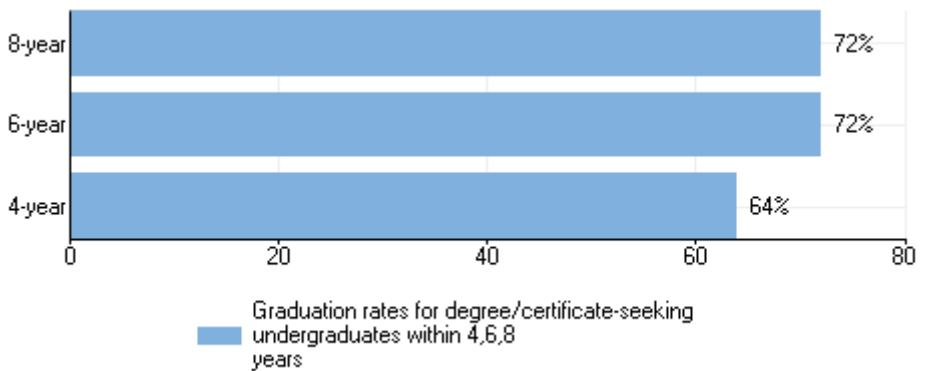

First to second year retention rates of first-time bachelor's degree-seeking undergraduates: Fall 2022



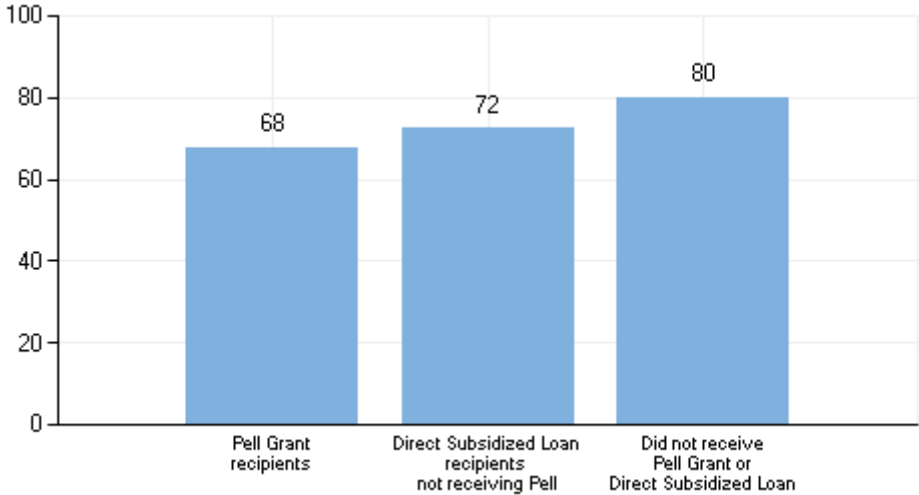

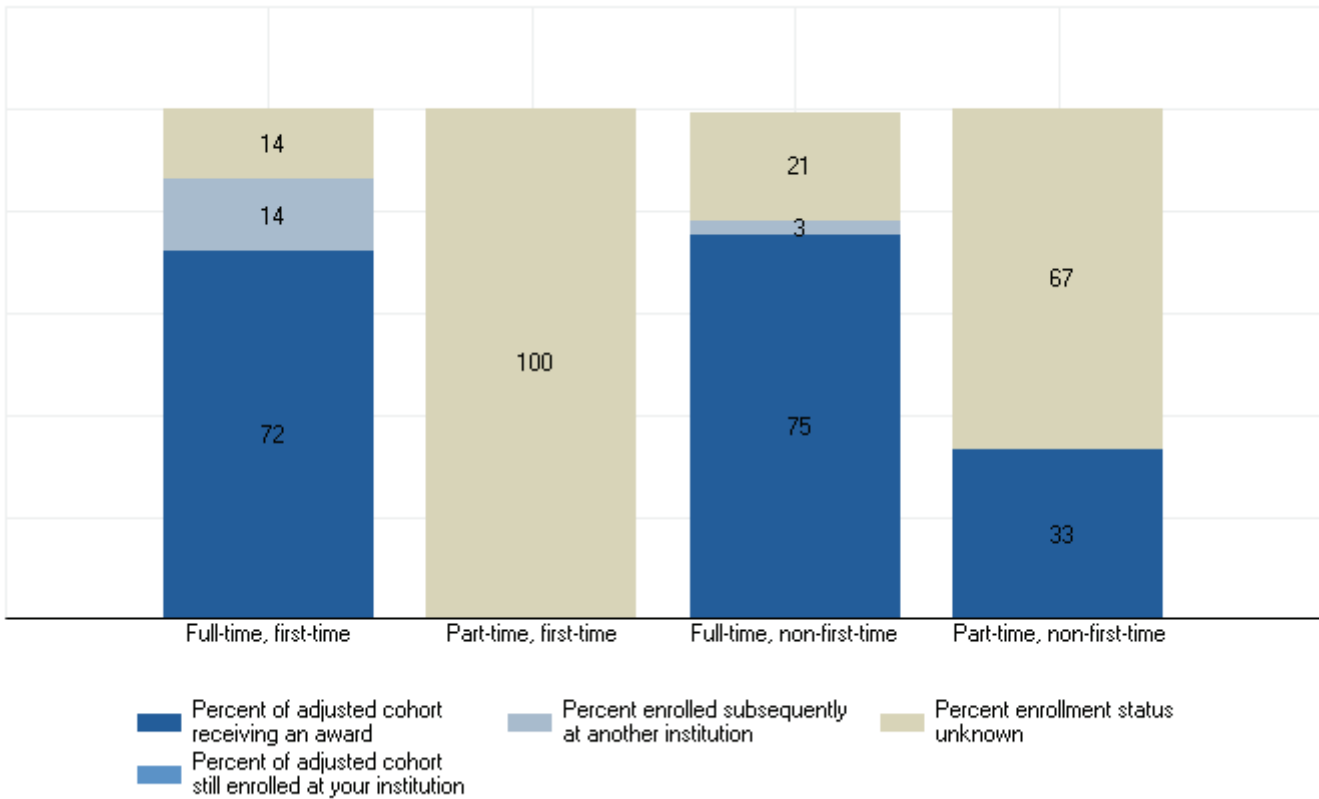
Graduation rates of full-time, first-time, degree/certificate-seeking undergraduates within 150% of normal time to program completion, by Title IV aid status: 2016 cohort

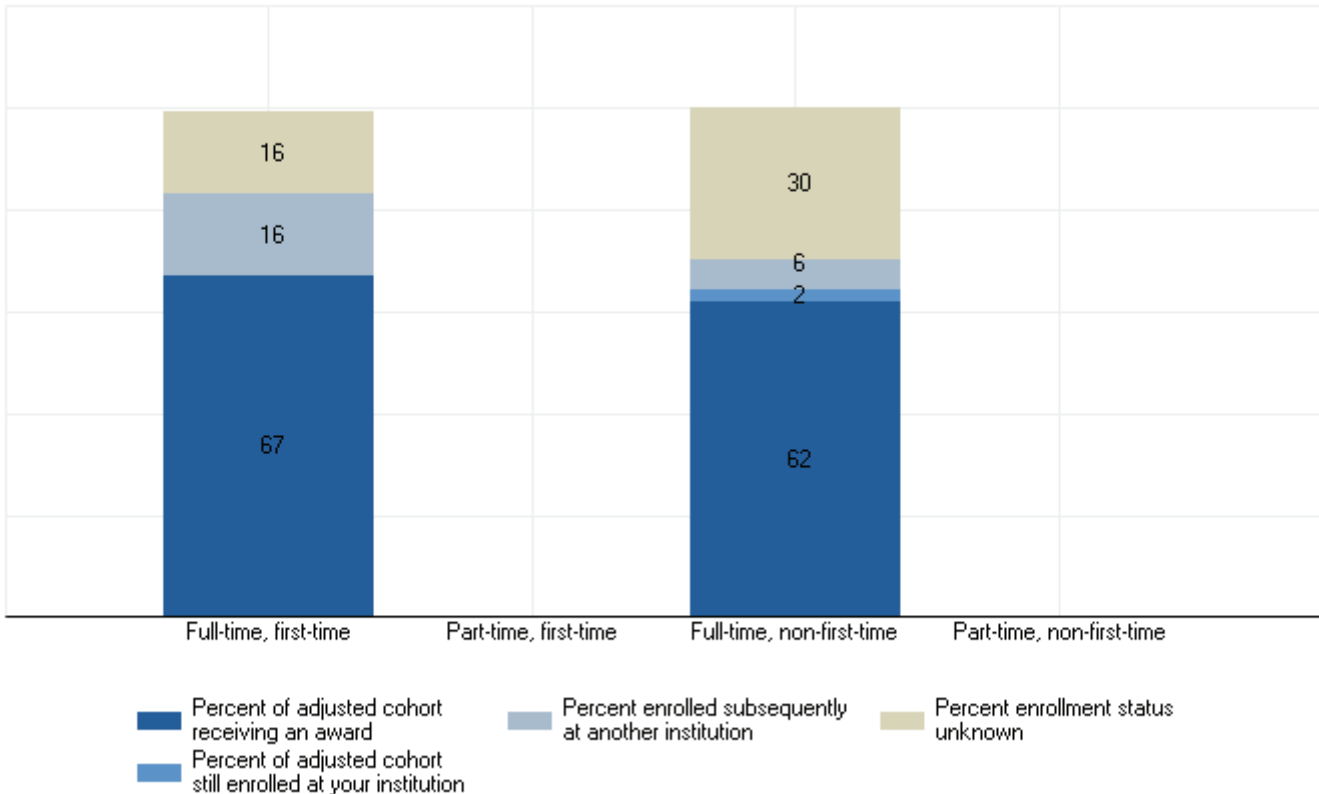

Award and enrollment rates of degree/certificate-seeking undergraduate students who entered the institution in 2014-15, by cohort

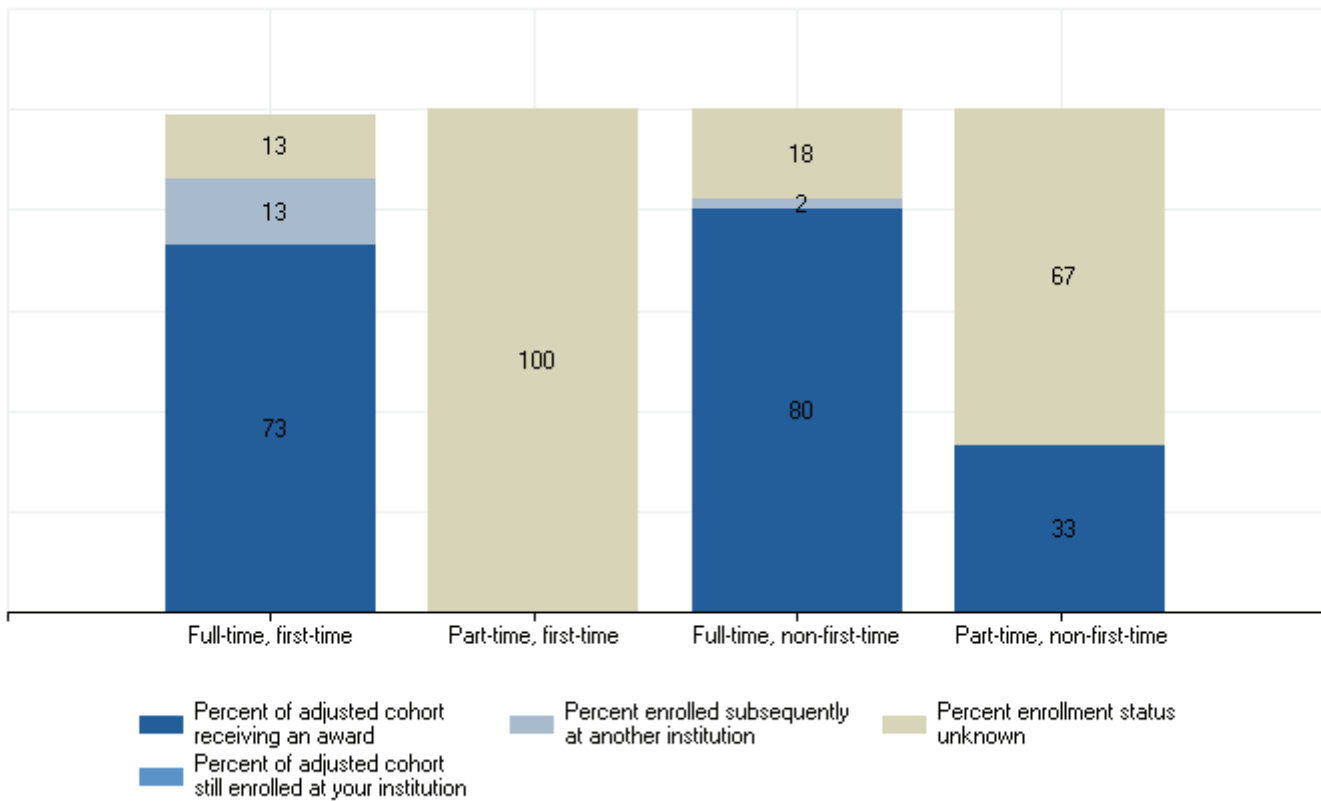


Award and enrollment rates of degree/certificate-seeking undergraduate students who entered the institution in 2014-15, by Pell status and cohort

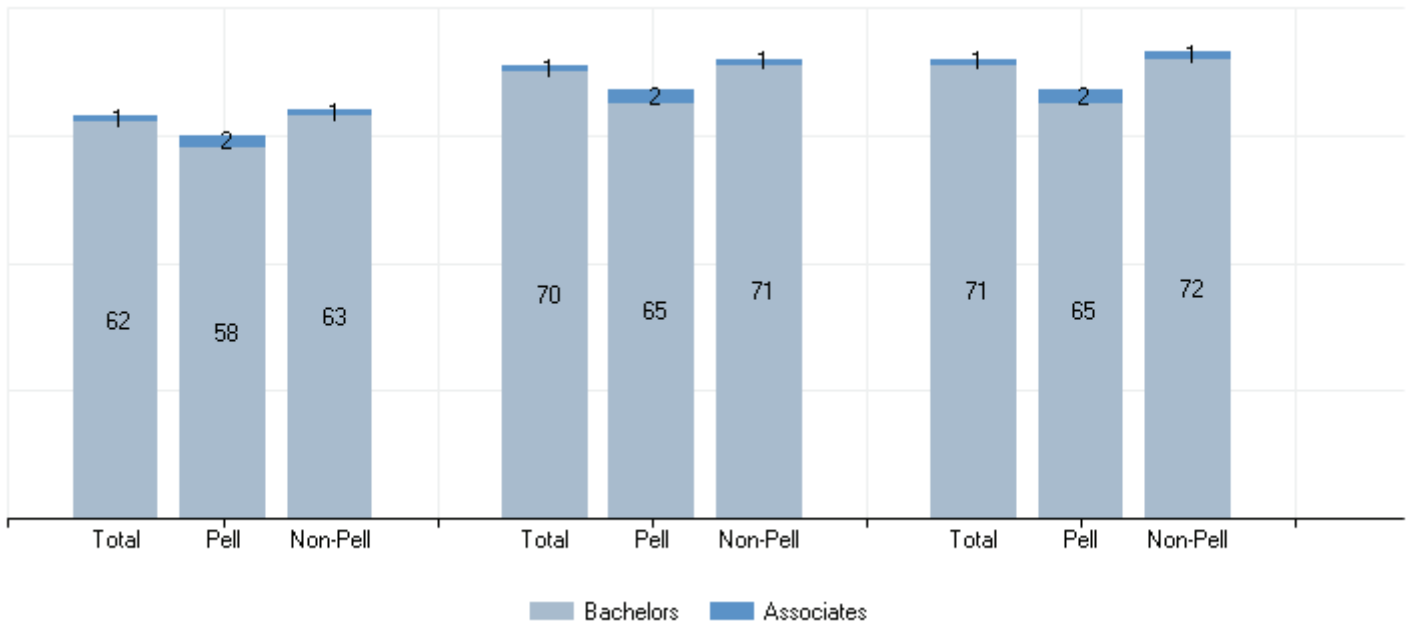


Students not receiving Pell Grants



Percent of full-time, first-time entering students receiving an award at four, six, and eight years after entry, by type of award and Pell status

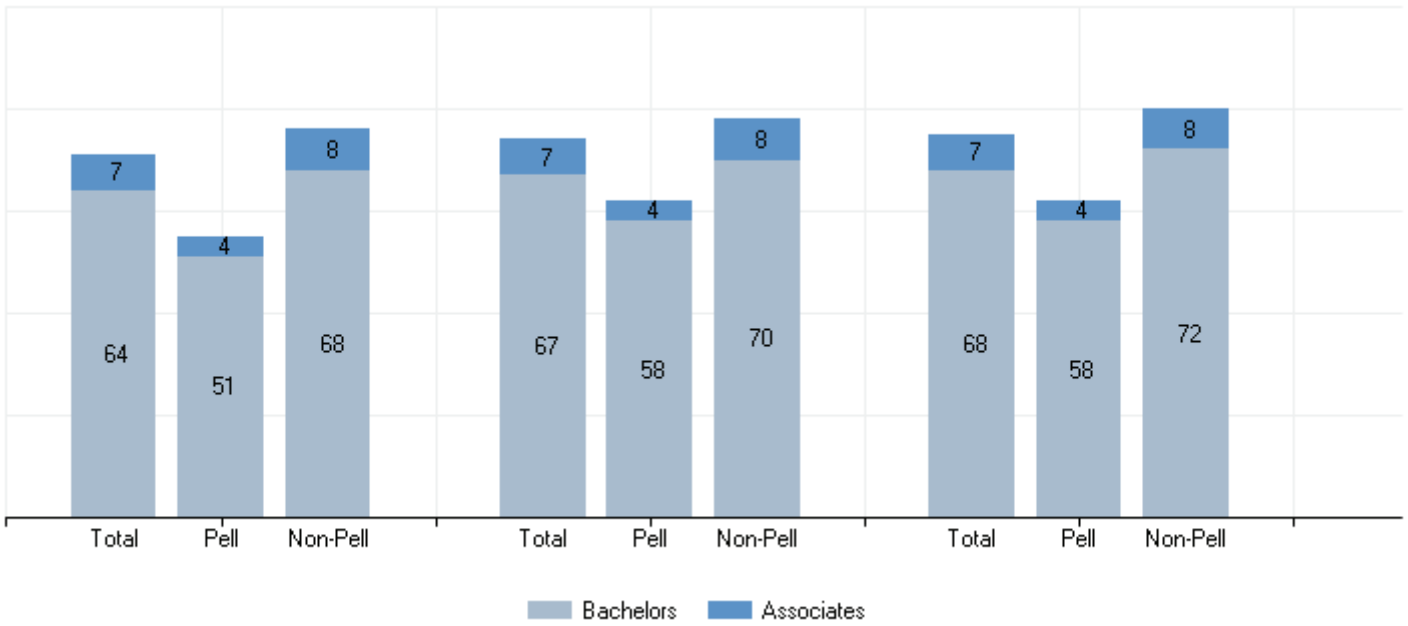

Percent of full-time, non-first-time entering students receiving an award at four, six, and eight years after entry, by type of award and Pell status

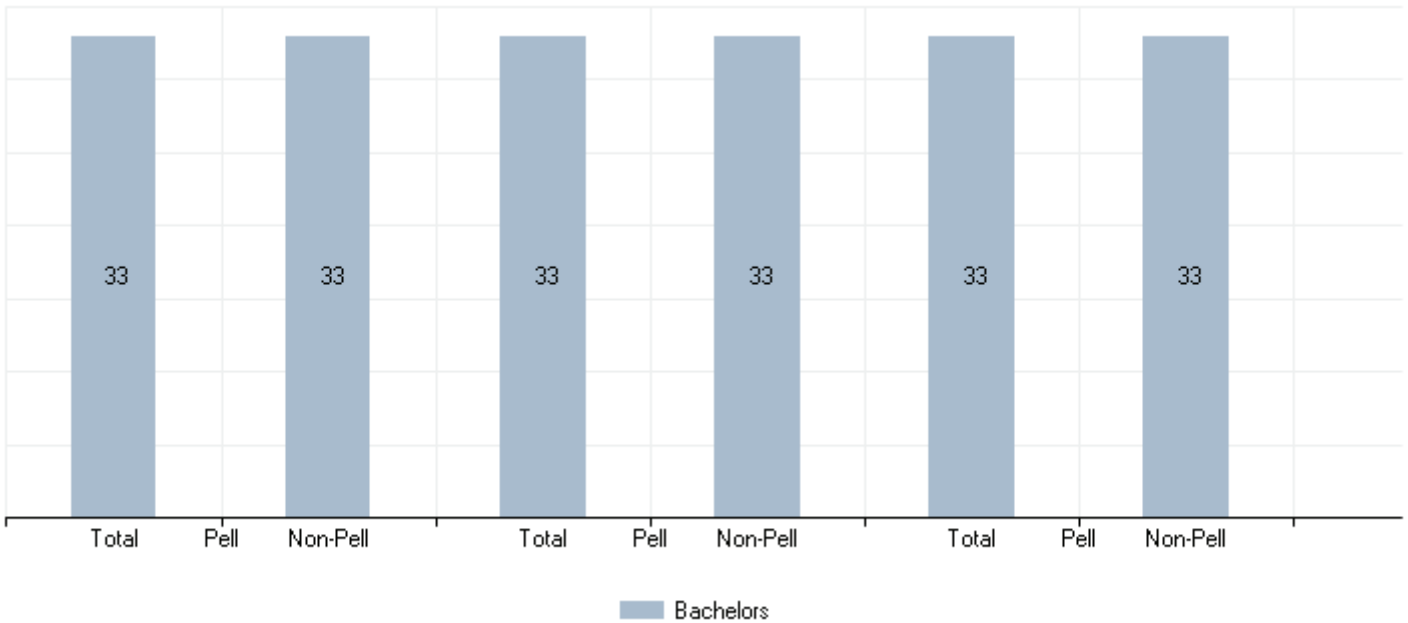

Percent of part-time, non-first-time entering students receiving an award at four, six, and eight years after entry, by type of award and Pell status

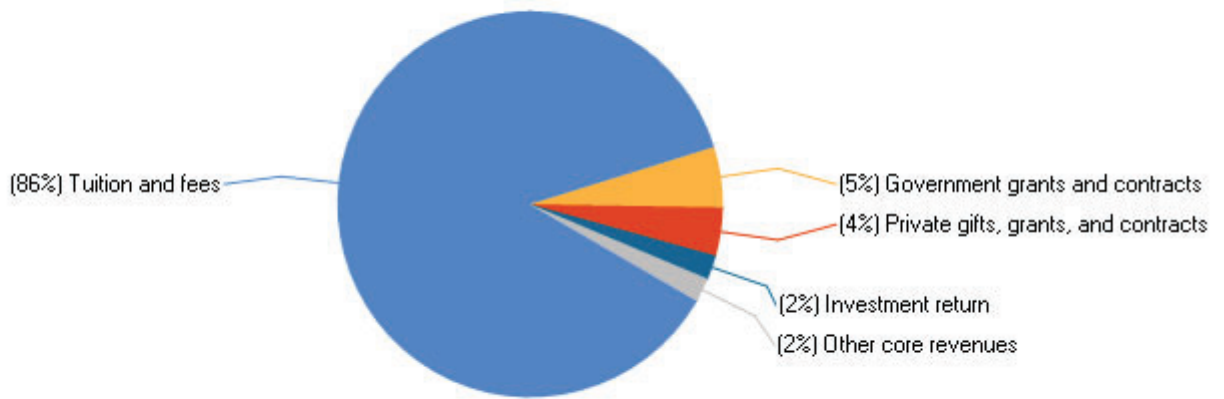

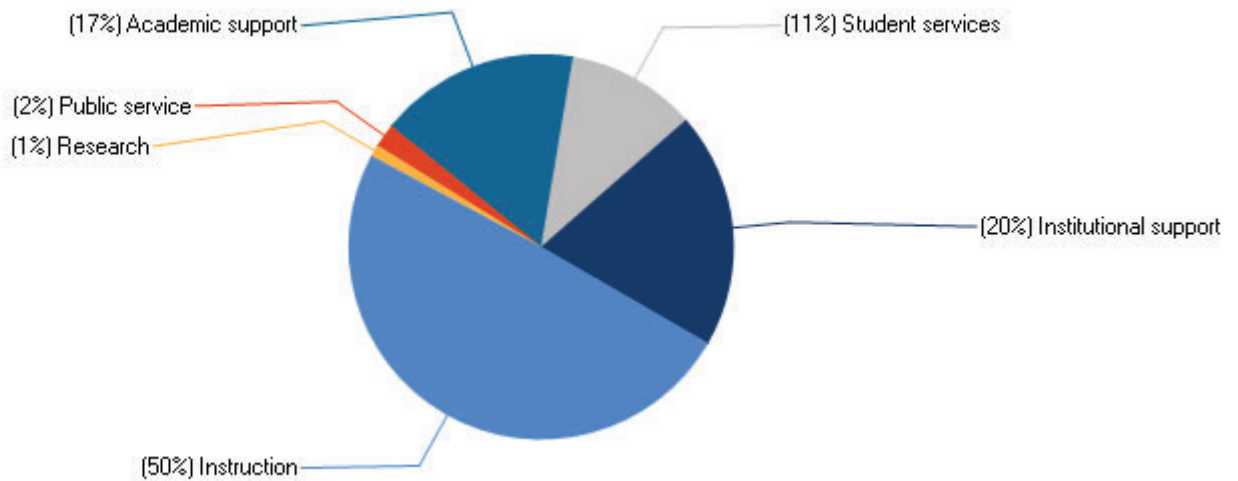
Percent distribution of core revenues, by source: Fiscal year 2022

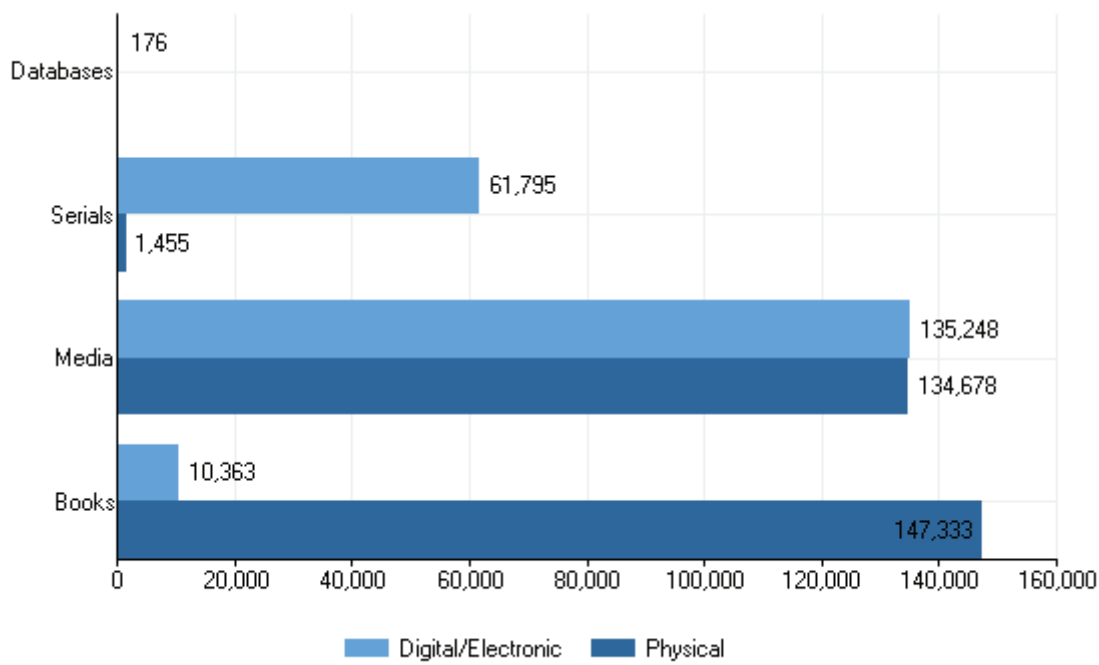
